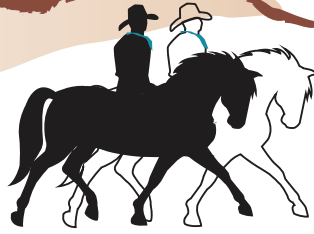

EVENT RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER, & INDEMNIFICATION. WE MUST HAVE A RELEASE SIGNED BY EACH RIDER.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in Day of the Horse («Event») to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Event with my horse, as a rider, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as a parent or guardian of a junior participant. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Event involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death («Harm»).

I AGREE to release the Event from liability for all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Event.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from negligence of the Event.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Event and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Event.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that «the Event» as used above includes all of its officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and any affiliated organizations.
