Returned checks will be assessed a \$25 fee. No refunds for failure to show in classes entered without written authorization from veterinarian. No refund on scratched classes.

Directions: From North or South: Take Highway 280 to Sand Hill Road exit in Woodside. Travel west on Sand Hill approximately one mile. The Horse Park will be on your right. Follow signs to SMCHA parking.

Food and beverages will be available on the show grounds.

DEFINITIONS

GIMMICK: Any humane training device will be accepted under the judge's discretion. Examples: Two hands, noseband, martingales, etc

First and Second Year Green: Pleasure, Reining and Trail horses in their first or second year of showing in that event, not shown before January 1, 2009.

Riders under 17: All junior riders in Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes must wear properly fitted protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling and exercise areas, the Show ring and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted.

Helmets and Attire: Riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the show grounds, must wear protective headgear (exceptions: trail classes). The Show Committee must prevent riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may prevent any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Cross-entering: Riders may cross enter into lope/canter classes.

HUNTER UNDER SADDLE: Classes will work both directions of the ring at walk, trot and canter. Horses need not be braided. Riders will wear suitable attire including protective helmet. Running and standing martingales are permitted in over-fence classes EXCEPT where rail work is included.

WESTERN CLASSES: Horses 5 and under (junior horse) may be shown in hackamore or snaffle. Horses 6 and over (senior horse) must be ridden one hand in the bridle with a western bit.

NOVICE RIDER: Not to have won three first place ribbons in that event prior to 1/1/10.

NEVER-WON-A-BUCKLE CLASS. NEVER won a buckle in that event, including end of the year for that division, a playday or a schooling show. YOU MUST ENTER AT LEAST ONE OTHER CLASS IN THAT DIVISION TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BUCKLE CLASS.

RANCH HORSE REQUIREMENTS: The rider is required to wear a hat, long sleeve shirt, boots and a belt. A tie and chaps are optional. Working man apparel is required; no glitzy shirts. The equipment for the horse should be plain. The saddle should have no silver except for conchos, horn cap and name plate. The bridle should have a plain headstall, but the bit can have silver. Snaffles and hackamores are allowed if the horse is the correct age for the equipment.

The gaits for the Ranch Horse classes should be forward moving. The walk, jog and lope should all be forward moving like a Ranch Horse would move while working. An extended jog is required. Extreme slowness will be penalized. Too low of a head carriage will also be penalized. Ears below the withers are considered too low. In the Trail Class, there will be a rope test where the rider will throw and then drag the rope. A slicker/coat will be put on and then removed. The rider will have to mount and dismount. The use of a stool will be allowed.
