The Versatility Ranch Horse competition promotes the athletic ability and versatility of the horse and is demonstrated in five categories - ranch riding, ranch trail, ranch cutting, working ranch and ranch conformation. Morning instruction will consist of trail obstacles, ranch riding & reining work. Afternoon cow work will consist of learning how to box a cow and bring it down the fence, how to pull a cow out of the herd, keep it separated from the herd, control it down the fence and put it in a pen. *Open to intermediate and advanced riders only. Must be comfortable extending the lope and learning how to work a cow. This clinic is not designed for green riders.*



All participants are to enter the arena at 9:00am in order to warm up their horse.

Clinic will start promptly at 10 am.
